MEDICO-LEGAL

I was appointed Consultant Physician and Gastroenterologist in Leeds in 1982 and worked at Seacroft and St James's University Hospitals and at Leeds General Infirmary on a full-time basis until 2012, during which I was also in regular Private practice. I retired from full-time work as a Consultant Physician and Gastroenterologist in Leeds Teaching Hospitals Trust at the end of March 2012, following which I worked part-time for the Trust two days a week until September 2013, when I retired from the Trust. I retired from Private Medical Practice in March 2014 but I continue to do regular NHS Clinics and Endoscopy sessions for 'Living Care' in Leeds and Pontefract.

My work for the NHS involved running a busy GI practice, including out-patient and in-patient work and all types of GI endoscopy. I regularly saw over 700 new outpatients per year and I developed particular expertise in colonoscopy and ERCP and their complications. My particular areas of interest within gastroenterology include pancreatobiliary disease, benign and malignant gastro-oesophageal disease, functional gut disorders and inflammatory bowel disease. Over the years I have had a research interest in pancreatic disease, although I have not published in this field recently.

I also held a number of management appointments within the NHS and was Clinical Director for GI medicine within the Leeds Hospitals Trust from 1999 to 2008. I was Chairman of the Specialist Training Committee for Gastroenterology in the Yorkshire Deanery from 1996 to 2000 and President of The Pancreatic Society of Great Britain and Ireland from 1997-98.

I was Chairman of the British Society of Gastroenterology Clinical Services and Standards Committee for three years until 2007, Chairman of the BSG Audit Committee from 2002 to 2010 and a member of the Endoscopy Committee from 2007 to 2010. I have also served on the Pancreatic Section Committee on a number of occasions in the past. In October 2012 I stepped down from the Board of Trustees of CORE (previously the British Digestive Diseases Foundation), having served on it for three years.

I began my medicolegal practice in 1989 and currently provide approximately 20 Expert reports per annum (95% Claimant and 5% Defendant, of which approximately 80% are single instructions and 20% joint instructions). I have a wide experience of gastroenterology, including dyspepsia, functional gut disorders, the management of inflammatory bowel disease, for which I ran a Joint Specialist clinic together with a Colorectal Surgeon for more than 20 years, and General Medicine. I have a specialist interest in pancreatobiliary disease and during my time as a Consultant in the NHS I was regularly involved in the management of patients with such problems.
